4. **Trust Land Money-** this year about \$23,000 next year possible \$32,000

School Recommends Credit Recovery & ACT Prep

Goals #1 – improve Sage scores in language arts by 30%, and math by 20%.

Increasing Literacy in the classroom by:

- Repeated reading and timed reading
- Reading assessments
- Math, timed math
- Vocabulary and vocabulary concepts (speed)

Goal #2 – improve graduation rates, attendance improve to 85% this year and 90% by next year.

- Tracking attendance in two week increments. Teachers set attendance goals with students.
- Having a strong staff lead credit recovery program. Students come with no hope to graduate but through credit recovery they can.

Goal #3 – Improve classroom conditions for learning.

- Co-Pilot surveys students take in class that provides teachers information on conditions for learning. The teachers work in groups with the information to come up with strategies to improve conditions.

School Recommends Credit Recovery & ACT Prep

Reviewed and approved EHH Land Trust Money being spent on Credit Recovery and ACT Prep including staffing, and necessary equipment/software for these programs. Carol moved to approve, Angela second, the vote was unanimous.

5. Digital Citizenship/Safe Technology

- School has “iboss” filtering software, school is happy with it.
- Students and parents sign at registration “Acceptable Use” for computer use.
- Most computers are supervised and arranged for easy supervision.
- Mobile labs need to be updated.
- Last year broke all material into 3 Advisory sessions
 - i. Council recommends setting up a plan for next year early to spread out the training more.
- This year advisory’s will go over the training with the specific grade.
