We are writing to let you know that East Hollywood High School has been designated as a Title I Comprehensive Support and Improvement school for Graduation Rates. This designation means that the school's average graduation rate for the previous three years was below 67%. East Hollywood's three-year average graduation rate was 66.7%.

The program improvement designation provides an opportunity for principals, teachers, and parents to focus on areas of school improvement. The Utah State Board of Education are working with East Hollywood High School to improve teaching and learning, especially in the areas of reading and mathematics, by providing technical assistance and professional development opportunities to the teachers and administrators within your school.

East Hollywood High School is working to improve its academic program by undergoing a rigorous school improvement effort led by a school system of support team. However, parent support is essential to the success of the school improvement efforts.

Parents can effectively assist student achievement improvement in the following ways:

- Communicating frequently with your student's teachers
- Making sure your student attends school regularly
- Helping your student with schoolwork.
- Monitoring your student's screen time
- Monitoring your student's academic progress.
- Participating in school decision-making

We want to request your help as the school addresses its academic needs and will Invite parents to serve on the committee that will develop a school improvement plan.
